Asthma

What is Asthma?

Asthma is a chronic or long-term disease of the airways, the tubes that carry air into our lungs. It causes inflamation and narrowing of the bronchial tubes that leads to airway narrowing and difficulty breathing. The airways of our lungs are surrounded by muscles and contain muscas glands. These muscles are normally relaxed, but when people with asthma encounter triggers, these muscles become inflamed, react by tightening, and the airways can fill with muscas. This makes breathing very difficult and leads to asthma symptoms or an asthma attack (exacerbation).
