Health Topic

Staying Safe Under the Sun

- Cover up. When the UV Index is 3 or higher, protect your skin as much as possible. Wear light colored, longsleeved shirts, pants, and a wide brimmed hat made of breatheable fabric. When you buy sunglasses, make sure they provide protection against both UVA and UVB rays.
- Always apply sun screen if outdoors, SPF 30 or higher.
- Keep hydrated, drink plenty of water.
- If you feel weak and nauseated after being in the sun for an extended period of time, slowly sip water and seek medical help.
