



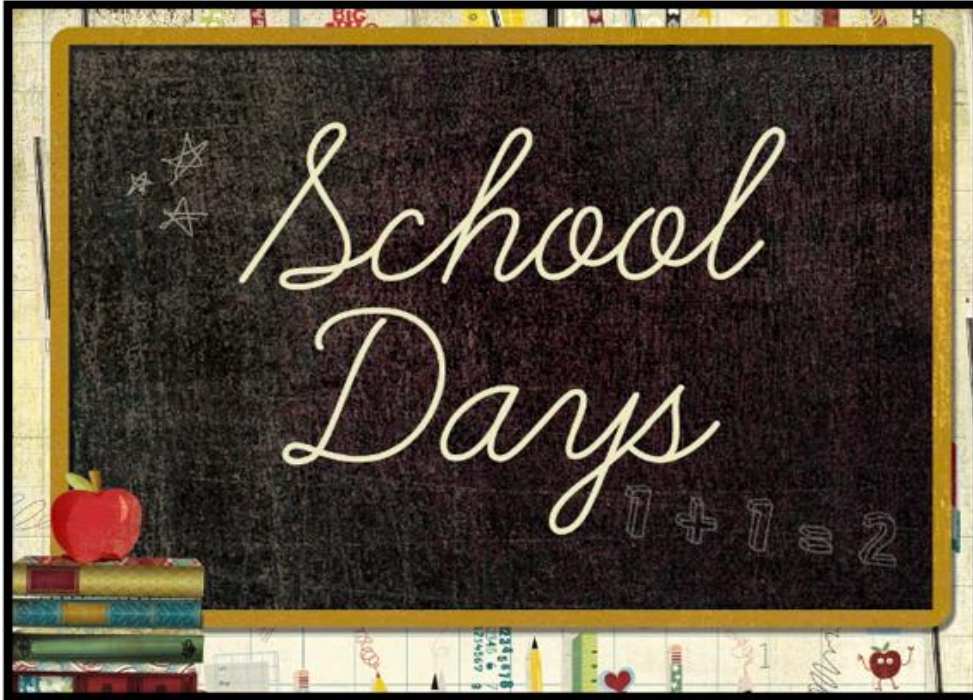

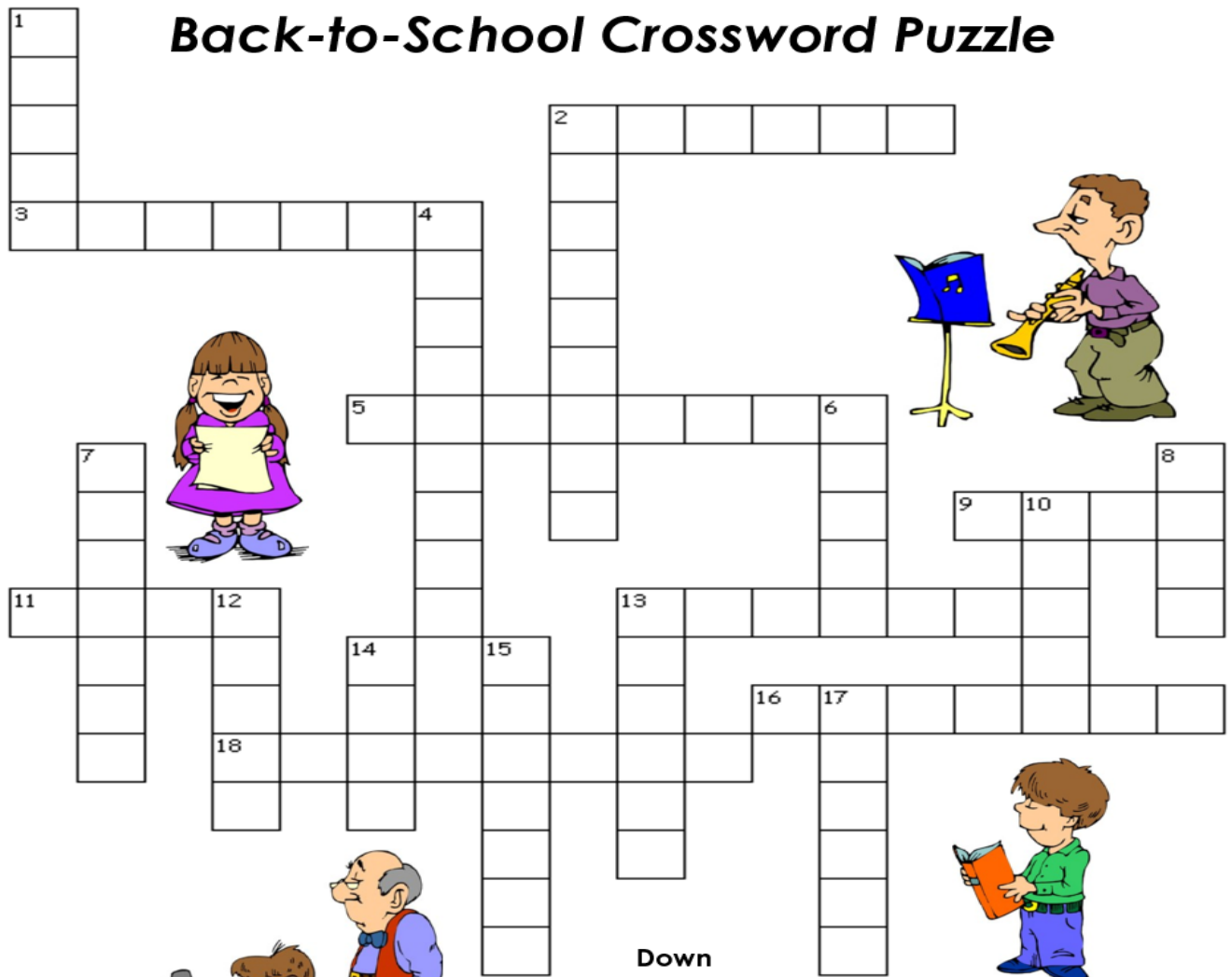
We are excited to continue our fun recreation programs and to see some familiar and new family and friends join us!
